## Anderson Lake State Park

This is a scenic area to ride in with the lake as a backdrop on well-maintained trails. Each trail is only a mile or so, but there are 5 or 6 that are easy to connect to and so an hour or two of enjoyable riding is easily done.

## Getting There

About 25 miles from Sequim, follow 101 E to Hwy 20 headed to Port Townsend. After 3.7 miles, turn right onto Anderson Lake Road. The Park entrance is a little over 1 mile up this road.

Note that the park gate is only open from April to October 31. There is no parking available at other times.

## **Parking**

Inside the park there is plenty of good trailer parking in a grassy field, and even water for horses. A Discover Pass is required and there is a further access fee of \$10/day or \$30/year.
