

# FOOTHILLS TRAILS (January , 2026 )

- **Name of Trail :** Foothills Trail
- **Location:** Head west into Port Angeles, left on Race, right on Lauridsen Blvd., left on 101. Go about 1/4 mile to the right onto Pine St., left at the stop sign. Road will turn into Black Diamond Road, follow up the hill to Little River Rd., take a left and follow a gravel road about a mile up the hill , parking lot will be on your left. You can also come in off of Hurricane Ridge Road. **DISCOVER PASS REQUIRED!**
- **Parking:** Lots of parking available.
- **Trail description :** Trails are rocky, dirt, gravel, foot protection or shoes recommended. Trails are also pretty good in wet winter weather. **NOTE:** This is DNR land, so it is multi-use with a shooting area across the road, so gunfire may be heard.
- **Comments:** This trail is recommended for horses with some varied trail experience. Some of the trails are a little narrow and somewhat hilly. This trail is not recommended for beginners.
- **Outstanding features:** There are many trails with beautiful views and a picnic table with a rail fence is at the top. A GPS app will allow the rider to see all of the trails.

- Get on US-101 W/E Hwy 101 from S Sequim Ave  
2 min (0.6 mi)
- Follow US-101 W/E Hwy 101 to N Race St in Port Angeles  
21 min (15.5 mi)
- Continue to US-101 W/E Lauridsen Blvd  
4 min (1.5 mi)
- Turn left onto US-101 W/E Lauridsen Blvd  
57 sec (0.5 mi)
- Follow Black Diamond Rd to Little River Rd  
13 min (6.1 mi)
- Foothills Multi-use Trail Head
