Gold Creek Trailhead

The Gold Creek trail traverses through an old logged-off area, which provides views of the summit you're headed to. Note there is also a horse camp at Green Mountain, with perhaps a dozen corral and non-potable water.

Restrooms available, Discover Pass required.

Getting There

The Gold Creek Trailhead is in Kitsap county, right off of 1398 Gold Creek Rd, W. Bremerton. This means it's a bit over an hour from Sequim. When going south on HWY 3, take the Newberry Road Exit. Turn right onto NW Newberry Hill Road and go 3 miles to Seabeck Hwy NW. After 2 miles, take the 1st exit at the traffic circle onto NW Holly road. Stay on Holly road for 4.2 miles, then turn left only Tahuyeh Rd NW. After 1.2 miles turn left only Gold Creek Rd NW. In 1.8 miles turn left into the Gold Creek Trailhead.
