## Mount Muller/Littleton Horse Camp

This is a longer drive from Sequim but well worth it because Mr Muller not only has a terrific loop trail that takes kyou up the mountain for fantastic views, but there's horse camping at the base this can be an overnight trip.

## **Getting There**

From Port Angeles take 101 West for 32 miles, about 4.5 miles past Fairholm. Turn right on Forest Road #3071 and go another .3 miles to the trailhead. The horse camp is another ½ mile up the road and accommodates 10 campers and includes corrals for horses.

## Trail Map

The loop is 13 miles and hits an elevation of 3748 ft, so it's a good climb. There are mountain bikers and hikers on this trails, but there is usually no crowds. This trail has lots of viewpoints, meadows along the way, and since it's a loop, you won't find it hard to get home.
